CREATIVE TIME'S 2013 FALL BALL DELIVERED "DANCE-ART MARATHON"

Public art organization's annual fundraiser drew hundreds of attendees

Party featured art, live music and performances, signature cocktails, colorful installations, mimes, and much more

November 13, 2013 – New York, NY – Last night, Creative Time yet again brought together the worlds of art, fashion, nightlife and design at its sold-out annual fall fundraiser, which took place at **Output** in Williamsburg, Brooklyn. This year's party—hosted by Creative Time Board member **Jon Neidich**, the Creative Time Ambassadors, **Claude Morais** and **Brian Wolk** of Ruffian, and a select host committee—celebrated the vibrant diversity of the New York art world and, in true Creative Time style, was as innovative and surprising as the public art projects that the organization regularly produces. Artist **Alex Da Corte** created a profusion of brightly-colored roses dipped in rubber, which decorated the main stage and were handed out to guests by mimes near the end of the evening. **Eske Kath** created a large-scale installation around the DJ booth that suggested jungle-like scenes made of large painted wooden leaves and flowers. **Andrea Mary Marshall**'s mixed-media series *Self-Portraits As Vanitas* lined the walls of the venue, and **André Saraiva**'s limited-edition "Dream Poster" prints were ubiquitous throughout the space and wheat-pasted on the streets of Williamsburg and downtown Manhattan. DJs **JD Samson, Tiki Disco**, and **Jeffrey Tonnesen** got the audience rocking out, and performers **The Dolls**—featuring DJ **Mia Moretti** and singer/violinist **Caitlin Moe (aka 'Margot')** with a string quartet—had guests jumping to their feet to dance the night away in the completely packed venue until well past 1:00AM.
