Creative Time has brought New York public art events ranging from Julian LaVerdiere's poignant 9/11 memorial *Tribute in Light* to Vik Muniz's playful skyline-shaping *Clouds*. Now comes an exhibition boiling over with spells, séances, and the occasional apparition. Disturbing a reportedly haunted space, *Strange Powers* features the work of over 20 artists divining inspiration from the spirit world. The show's potent brew includes Jim Lambie's *Psychedelic Soul Stick*, Anne Collier's images of artists' auras, and a psychic investigation by video artists Sophie Calle and Fabio Balducci. Additionally, guests attending tonight's opening will find Christian Cummings consulting his ouija board to create a series of otherworldly drawings.
